- Our aim is to improve attendance across school and to work with you if there are barriers to your child achieving good attendance or in getting in on time.
- We review every child's attendance and punctuality once a fortnight. At the moment we will contact you if your child's attendance is below 92% or they are regularly late. You may be asked in for a meeting so we can work with you to get a better understanding of the situation and improve things.
- If attendance does not improve, we will consult with the attendance team at Norfolk County Council about legal measures that may be required.
- We hope to have a new Parent Support Adviser and an Attendance Officer in school by the beginning of next half term. They will be able to offer you support.
