## What is the SEN register and an IEP?

The Special Educational Needs Register is a list of children who have an identified special need in their education and require an Individual Education Plan (IEP) to help them make progress with their learning. An IEP is individual to each child. The targets have been written as a result of careful assessments and will be reviewed after each term. A child may have an IEP throughout their school or may have one for a short period of time.
